The Saint Luke's Young Investigator Award is sponsored by St Luke's Hospital and the Royal Academy of Medicine in Ireland. This is the fifth year of the award. They must submit electronically an abstract of completed work of not more than 500 words, written as IJMS abstracts, and include a brief CV. They must indicate the role they have played in this submitted work. Four finalists, selected by the St Luke's/Academy Committee will present a 10 minute presentation followed by a 5 minute discussion about their work on the evening of the 23rd May at Number 6 Kildare Street. The winner will receive the Academy's Bronze Medal and an award of €800.
