APPLICATION FOR THE IRISH JOURNAL OF MEDICAL SCIENCE DOCTOR AWARDS

The awards are open to all those involved in medical research who have had a clinical research paper published in an indexed journal between July 2007 and July 2009.

The research must have been totally or significantly carried out in Ireland.

- All entries must be accompanied by six reprints of the published paper.
- All entries must be accompanied by a recent head and shoulders colour photograph.
- Each entry form must contain the mobile phone number, address and email address of the applicant.
- The applicant must ensure that they are able to attend the awards ceremony and, if they are unable to attend, must nominate someone to attend in their place.
